INTERDISTRICT TRANSFERS

**No Interdistrict
Transfers**

A nonresident student shall not be permitted to attend District schools except as provided below.

Exceptions

*Resident Student
in Grade 12
Becomes
Nonresident*

A resident student in grade 12 who becomes a nonresident during the school year shall be permitted to continue in attendance, on a tuition-free basis, for the remainder of the school year if the student has been a resident of the District for the two years immediately prior to his or her senior year.

*Child of
Nonresident
Employee*

A nonresident employee may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent or designee.

*Students
Accepted as
Transfers Prior to
August 1, 2019*

A student who was accepted as a transfer student prior to August 1, 2019, shall be allowed to apply for transfer on an annual basis until graduation, so long as he or she meets the terms of the transfer agreement.

Siblings of a student who was accepted as a transfer student prior to August 1, 2019, may apply for transfer so long as the original transfer student is enrolled in the District.

*No Right or
Expectation of
Transfer*

Acceptance of a transfer student in one school year shall create no right or expectation that the student shall be admitted as a transfer student in subsequent years. Admission of one student in a family as a transfer student shall create no right or expectation that another student from the same family shall be admitted as a transfer.

Factors

In approving transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider availability of space and instructional staff and the student's disciplinary history and attendance records.

*Transfer
Agreements*

Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time, on a tuition-free basis. A transfer student shall be notified in the written transfer agreement that he or she must follow all rules and regulations of the District. Violation of the terms of the agreement may result in a transfer request not being approved the following year.

Transportation

The District shall not be responsible for transportation of transfer students except as required by law.

Appeals

Any appeals shall be made in accordance with FNG(LOCAL) and GF(LOCAL), as appropriate.
