

P3 Campus – Anonymous Reporting

In an effort to keep students and staff safe, we encourage everyone to follow the model of “See Something, Say Something”. Reporting issues and concerns and having them addressed quickly and efficiently is paramount. For the past few years, we have had an anonymous tip line for our students, parents, and community to make reports. It was called “Quick Tip” and it was located on the district website. We now have a new system called “P3 Campus”. It is still an anonymous reporting system, but it offers additional features. It is monitored 24/7 in collaboration with the Guadalupe County Sheriff’s Office to insure that reports are received without delay. It also can be utilized as an app on most cell phones. To put it on your phone, go to your app store and search for “P3 Campus”. Follow the prompts to install it and set up your account for the district or your child’s respective campus. It can also still be accessed from the district and campus websites on the left side of the screen under “Quicklinks” by clicking on “P3 Campus- Anonymous Reporting”. If you need further assistance with downloading the app on your device or with accessing the system on the website, please contact your child’s campus office and they will assist you. Middle school and high school students have received a training on “P3 Campus” and are being encouraged to use it. Working together, we can all do our part to keep our students, staff, and community safe.
